

Millgrove Early-Bird Tournament - May 14, 15 and 16, 2010

Rules and Regulations

Note: All games will be played at the Millgrove diamonds

1. This tournament will use 2009 ISC II rules unless they conflict with the rules below.
2. Teams must be recreational or intermediate with a maximum of one positional player from a 2009 ISC roster.
3. No pitchers from the 2009 ISC II ineligible list will be permitted to pitch.
4. Rosters must be submitted by May 6, 2010 with a maximum of 20 players.
5. Alcohol consumption will not be permitted outside the designated area at Millgrove Park.
6. Any teams guilty of breaking any of the above rules will forfeit the entry fee, any prize money they would be entitled to and will be removed from the tournament.
7. Any rained out games will be rescheduled as required, at the discretion of the tournament organizers.
8. All teams are guaranteed 4 games.
9. Games will be 7 innings unless in a mercy situation or the time limit has expired.
10. The time limit for round-robin and semi-final games is 1 hour and 20 minutes after the first pitch. When the time limit is reached, the inning will be completed, but no additional innings will start. There is no time limit during the A, B and C finals on Sunday.
11. The home team for all games will be decided prior to the game by a coin-flip.
12. Teams must start with a minimum of 9 players and are allowed a 5 minute grace period from the scheduled start time or the result is a loss (defaults are scored 7-0).
13. The mercy rule is in effect for all round-robin and semi-final games: 7 runs after 5 innings.
14. Ties are not played out during the round-robin.
15. In the elimination round, if tied after 7 innings (or once the time limit is reached in the semi-finals) the international tie breaker is in effect.
16. Umpires reserve the right to eject players for profanity or intentionally trying to harm another player. Any suspensions include that game plus the team's next game, as a minimum.
17. All bats approved for use in ISC and ISC II play will be allowed.
