LORNE

"Gump" DAER

April 06, 1947 – April 8, 2011

Hometown – New Hamburg, ON

The 2011 class of inductees includes one of the game's truly ubiquitous ball-park faces of the past four decades, the late **Lorne Daer**. "**Gump**" was a knuckle – ball artist, change – up specialist who baffled batters as a member of the Woodstock Twins, Bengals and Tornadoes and Waterloo CHYM'rs

"Gump" was born in Goderich and spent his early years in Auburn where he embraced hockey. The Canadian sportsing lore of young goaltenders using Eatons catalogues as leg pads rings true for "Gumper", who guarded the goal old-style, ignoring the need to wear a mask similar to NHL netminder Worsley with whom he shared the revered nickname. He backstopped his team to the final game at the legendary Young Canada Hockey Week in Goderich and played his minor hockey years in the Salt Town on the shore, winning an Ontario Championship with his Goderich bantam team.

He enjoyed fastball as a youngster in Auburn, but it was after he moved from his hometown that he started his pitching career. His change-up tantalized opposing batters and was his "go-to" pitch that was the foundation of his many successful seasons on the mound.

He was a key cog in Ontario championship teams with Woodstock – the 1978 Intermediate title that required seven playoff rounds including the final against Schumacher, and the 1980 Senior B crown with the Woodstock Tornadoes.

His ever-present toothpick and his penchant for fun did not take away from his commitment to ferocity on the mound nor his value as a teammate to so many players across southern Ontario.

Lorne is survived by his wife June, daughter Laura (Todd Winkworth) and son Jason (Leighann).

ROBERT NOPARA

"Chubb" TANGAROA

Hometown – Hawke's Bay, NZ

If pitching is the benchmark of great teams then no moundsman is more deserving of being recognized as a Legend than the great "**Chubb**" **Tangaroa**, the first international player to be honoured at the Legends Classic. Chubb, another of the great New Zealand pitching fraternity plied his trade stateside beginning in 1981. His résumé includes toeing the rubber for the legendary Long Beach CA Night Hawks, Lancaster PA Chameleons, Denton TX Kings, Rohnert Park CA Guanella Brothers, Decatur IL Pride and Broken Bow NE Travelers. Chubb earned ISC All World honours in three successive years (1989-91) with the Quanella Brothers, and as well was a 3 – time ASA National Champion, twice with the Decatur IL Pride.

Internationally, Chubb was a member of the New Zealand Black Sox national team for 22 years (1982-2004), 16 years as a pitcher, and 6 as pitching coach, including the three peat ISF Championships in '96, '2000 and 2004. Currently he is back with the Black Sox as the pitching coach for the Kiwis who hope to recapture the gold in the championships that will be hosted on North Island, New Zealand in 2013.

He has fond memories of his North American career, and cites the Sioux City IA Penn Corp, Owen Sound ON Canadian Tiremen and the Salt Lake City UT Larry Miller Toyota squads as providing formidable batting line-ups. Chubb recalls ISC Hall of Famers Bill Boyer, Mark Sorenson and Tim Wahl among the toughest batters that he faced.

Chubb was inducted into the New Zealand Softball Hall of Fame in 2004, recognized with the country's Award of Merit in 2005, and last month was inducted into the Unison Hawke's Bay Sports Hall of Fame.

ADAM SMITH

Two-way all-star

Born – December 29, 1964

Hometown – Hagersville, ON

Pitching may have dominated the game over the years, but that did not deter one of the games great "warriors" from making both defense and offence a highlight reel of his career. From humble beginnings, **Adam Smith** proved that farmers know how to play this great game when he hooked up with Mt. Hope A's in 1986, and was a stand-out middle infielder in ensuing seasons in Ontario in Burlington, Owen Sound, Toronto, Oshawa and Kitchener-Waterloo, and in the USA in Green Bay WI and Decatur IL.

In the competitive ISC "Addie" was a 5 time ISC All-World player with 3 different teams (Toronto Gators, Decatur Pride and K-W Hallman Twins), two times Champion with Toronto Gators, (plus 6 other top three finishes). He earned a .322 lifetime ISC batting average, was the leading hitter in 2001 with a formidable .583 average, batted in the most runs (11) in 1995 and is one of only 5 players with 100 lifetime hits.

He won four Softball Canada gold medals and as an eleven year, stellar member of Canada's National Team (1989-2000), he earned two Pan-Am gold medals, and played at three World Championships, including a contributing role in Canada's last ISF gold medal in 1992.

Adam is one of the greatest second basemen of his or any generation of the game, and was a fearless competitor who excelled in every facet of the game. Slick fielding, (combining with shortstop Chris Jones as one of the best double-play tandems in the history of the game), power hitting, high average and in his prime, one of the fastest players in the game, are all acknowledged by team-mates and adversaries.

Adam and Lauren have three children – Jon 27, Rachel 20 and Eryn 11.

WELL DONE COMMITTEE!

DOUG DAVIES

Remembering the Coach

June 18, 1937 - January 18, 2011

The Legends of Fastball Classic is proud to dedicate the 2011 tournament in the memory, or memories, as there were many, of Doug Davies. The local sporting community lost one of its true characters with the passing of Doug, renowned as a longtime coach, critic, score-keeper, volunteer and beloved curmudgeon. For decades "Coach" befuddled umpires in the Kitchener Fastball League as the leader of the formidable Tien Hoa Inn powerhouse. His rakish style of questioning calls while providing a personal perspective to contents of the rule book, kicking dirt and instigating trouble was all part of his master plan to confuse officials and opposition alike – simply his way of rallying his troops and having fun. In that irony that mystifies us all, when Doug wasn't coaching in a game, he was often behind the plate "callin' 'em as he saw them" - as an umpire!

In his stellar professional career, he was a long-serving manager for the Federal Government at Canada Immigration - he was good at that too.

He was thrilled to be asked to serve as a coach with the Waterloo Twins in the late 1990s and took exceptional pride in standing in the coaching box at his first ISC World Tournament in 1998. Loved by colleagues, fastball people, family and friends, he was as compassionate as he was cantankerous, genuine as he was flashy, and as honest as he was devilish.

Beloved dad to daughter Jennifer and son Daniel, and "Grumpy" to seven grandchildren, he is greatly missed by the fastball community, his Canada Immigration peers and his life-line friends at AA.

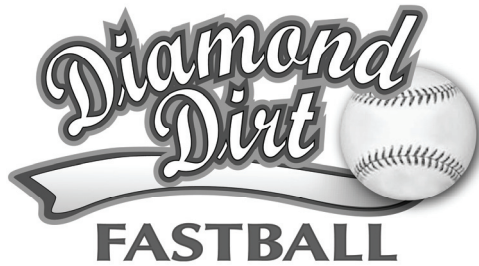
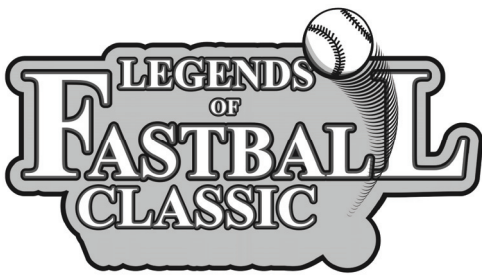
hosted the tournament 10 times (1961-69, 1973) and more recently, as part of Quad Cities, was the host venue for the 2009 championship.

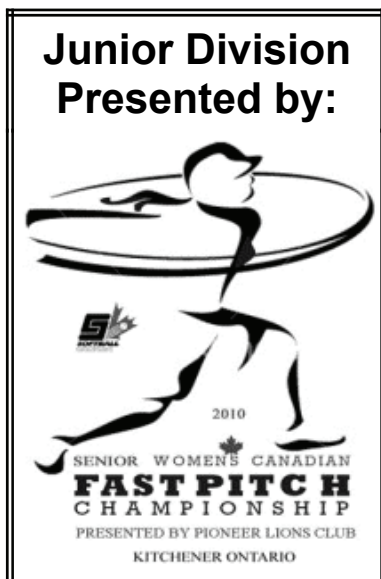
