**CAMP McGOVERN** is a charitable summer camp originally established in 1970 as a program of Big Brothers and later **Big Brothers & Big Sisters of Kitchener-Waterloo**. In 1999, the camp moved to its current site on 120 acres on the Saugeen River between Durham and Hanover. Each summer, more than 450 youth, many of whom are **Little Brothers, Little Sisters, Foster Children and children families served by United Way agencies** attend Camp McGovern. The camp’s goal is to provide quality programming and create a sense of community where kids feel comfortable to step out and challenge themselves when given a chance to explore, laugh and experience nature. Activities, songs, trips, friendships, mentoring and leadership opportunities make Camp McGovern special. Sharing experiences with others from similar backgrounds creates a sense of self-assurance and allows each camper to feel they have a place to fit in.
