

TRIBUTE TO BEAUMONT HAMEL

On July 1, 1916 waves of Allied soldiers began climbing out of their trenches to advance through a hail of enemy fire toward the German lines. It would be a tragic beginning to a costly battle where more than 57,000 Commonwealth soldiers would become casualties on the opening day of the fighting alone. The brave members of the Newfoundland Regiment who went into action near Beaumont-Hamel were hit especially hard, with only 68 of the more than 800 men who had taken part being able to answer the roll call the next morning. We will pay tribute to these men and their sacrifice which have allowed the freedoms that we enjoy today.

REMEMBERING OUR FANS

Newfoundland and Labrador boasts one of the best Senior Men's fastpitch leagues in Canada which has been in operation for 60 years. Not only have there been great players over that time period but there have also been some tremendous fans.
