

Annual Victoria Weekend Fastball Tournament Rules

May 19th – 22nd, 2017

1. Using a 4 Game Guarantee Schedule to allow team to maximize amount of games for entry fee
2. C.A.S.A. rules will apply unless otherwise stated.
3. Umpires will be using the ISC pitching rule.
4. Tournament Eligibility (This tournament will have same restrictions from 2016).
 - a. The tournament will not be allowing any players with current ISC PRAWN status on the 2016 Master list to participate in this years event. (See attached List)
 - b. The tournament will not be allowing any pitchers who are currently on the NAFA OPEN Classification list. (See attached List)
 - c. The tournament will not be allowing any players who are currently in the Senior Level National Team programs.
5. Players currently serving a suspension in an affiliated league is ineligible
6. Please submit team list prior or to first game if have not already done so. Any team caught with an "in-eligible" pitcher will forfeit any games the player participated in; with the possibility of the team being ejected from the tournament and entry their fee not to be returned. All Rosters are set once team play begins.
7. No infield practice prior to any game.
8. In the event of rain, the games will be rescheduled, as required, shortened game slots may be an alternative.
9. Umpire abuse will not be tolerated. The umpire's decision will be final. No appeals.
10. Any player ejected from a game will be required to sit out the next tournament game unless they are ejected for fighting, striking an umpire, or intentionally trying to injure another player, in which case they will be suspended from the remainder of the tournament.
11. Any team member or associate which initiates a fight at any time on tournament grounds will be ejected, as well as their entire team. Their entry fee will not be returned.
12. Sweaburg Parks and Rec Committee, the organizers, and volunteers of this tournament, East Zorra Township, Township of Southwest Oxford or the umpires will not be held liable for any injury incurred in or at this event.
13. There will be a licensed beer gardens. Any team member caught consuming alcohol outside the licensed area is subject to his team being disqualified from the tournament without refund. Police will routinely patrol the area.
14. The home team in the Preliminary Round will be decided by a coin flip prior to the start of each game (with the team travelling the furthest calling the flip) & in the Divisional Finals Higher seeded team will have the option of home team.
15. All teams must be ready to go at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. If teams are ready to go, we will start up to 15 minutes early for a game to help stay on schedule.
16. Games are to be (7) innings in length or 1 hour 30 minute time limit, with a (7) run mercy rule in effect, any point after 4 1/2 or 5-innings. If a home team is leading, they will not get a bat in the bottom half of the inning. No inning shall start after 1 hour and 30 minutes. No Time Limit for Semi-Finals and Finals.
17. The international tiebreaker rule will be used in all "extra" innings until a winner is determined
18. **Teams are expected to hustle at all times in order to ensure that as many innings as possible are played.**
19. After all the Preliminary games all teams will then be ranked according to their record in their 3 games.
20. For the purpose of calculating runs allowed and scored, all mercy games will count only as the 7 run differential.
21. In order to rank for the divisional seeding. The first consideration for seeding will be win-loss record; followed by head to head; followed by runs allowed per inning played; if a tie still remains we will look at least runs allowed; followed by most runs scored. If teams are still tied we will use a coin flip to break the tie. (For ties involving more than 2 teams. Once a tie is broken for one team, the tie-breakers are re-applied starting at the top of the list for the remaining teams.)
22. After ranking of the teams in their pools. "A" Division will be comprised of the 5 Pool winners (ranked 1 thru 5) plus the top 3 – 2nd place finishers). "B" Division will be comprised of the remaining 2 – 2nd place finishers plus the top 2 – 3rd place finishers. "C" Division will be comprised of the remaining 3 – 3rd place finishers plus the top 4th place finisher. (For seeding for Overall ties between pool place finishers, we will use the tie breaker rules)
