The score was unchanged until the action got hot and heavy in B6 and Delisle took the lead. Jeff Durham hit a 2-run shot scoring Ethier who had reached on error. Jeff Farion who had replaced Trevor Ethier in the circle was cruising, as he had not given up a hit to the 7 batters he had faced. The wheels fell off for Farion and Delisle in T7 when Bruno exploded for 3 more runs on 6 hits. Justin Dauvin's 2 run single was immediately followed by an Earl Ghostkeeper one run single to account for the damage. Delisle did not quit as they brought the winning run to plate thanks to a couple of singles, but could not score a run, thus suffering a bitter defeat.

He showed no signs of tiring coming into B7 but made one mistake to Evan Normand who led off the inning with a homer and took the game to extras. That mistake seemed to anger the Loggers as they exploded for 6 hits in the first extra inning, more than doubling the number of hits they had got off Caleb Keeshig to that point. **Ben Edginton** hit a 2-run triple and Hunter got one of his 3 hits to score another run. The logger offense came throughout the lineup as 5 different players had at least one RBI.
