# ISC 2007 CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNEYS Enthusiastic return to Kitchener, Cambridge

#### KITCHENER, ON – June 2007

Kitchener Fastball Promotions and partners are putting the finishing touches on plans for the 2007

**ISC Championships.** This year's tournaments marks back-to-back hosting – 2006 and 2007 - and the 3<sup>rd</sup> time in six years that the events have been held in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo.

The ISC World Tourney, scheduled for Peter Hallman Ball yard in Kitchener for nine days from Friday August 10 to Saturday 18 will crown a new champion, with the defending champion County Materials of Marathon, WI disbanding following a stint as three-peat champions. Early season predictions suggest that as many as eight or nine teams have legitimate shots at claiming the title, notably the #1 ranked Orillia Quaker Riversharks and the host Kitchener Hallman Twins.



# "Kiwi" Test Series vs Team Canada Premier world players to compete in SW Ontario

Team Canada, perennial Pan Am Gold medalists will lock horns with the defending International Softball Federation World Champions, the New

#### Zealand Community Trust Black Sox.

The six-game "test series" will renew a keen rivalry that has developed over the years between the two power-house men's national teams. New Zealand beat Canada 9-5 in the gold medal game in the 2004 world championships, hosted in Christchurch, NZ.

New Zealand Coach Eddie Kohlhase stated that "this test series provides us with the opportunity to play against the best competition in the World. The Black Sox hold our traditional foes Canada in the highest regards and we are absolutely excited at the prospect of playing quality international softball."

Canadian Coach Mark Smith shared "The test series against New Zealand provide the opportunity to measure ourselves against the World #1. Much like our team, New Zealand is in the preparation phase for the 2009 World Championships (hosted in Saskatoon, SK). This event represents a tremendous opportunity for both programs to evaluate performances."

# 4<sup>th</sup> annual Monkton World Fastball Invitational Top ranked teams to provide exciting competition June 28-July 1

The 4th annual **Monkton World Fastball Invitational Tournament** is scheduled for the Canada Day Weekend (June 28-July 1) on the single diamond in beautiful Monkton, Ontario.

Tournament Chair Brian Baillie and his committee of local volunteers and service club members are all set to stage another action-packed weekend of community events.

The roster of scheduled teams includes the seven top-ranked ISC teams, and is easily the early season preview for the ISC World Tournament to be held in Kitchener in August.

Competing teams include:

#1 ranked Orillia Quaker Riversharks, fresh off its tournament title at the 2007 Legends Tournament in Woodstock. #2 New York Patsy's – the powerhouse team that surprised many at the 2006 ISC #3 – Broken Bow Gremlins – a collaborative effort between the past world champion Broken Bow Travellers and the competitive New York Heflin Gremlins. #4 – Kitchener Hallman Twins, host of the 2007 ISC, and return of veteran ISC Coach Larry Lynch.

#5 – Madison, WI The Farm Tavern – a team with a fresh look assembled by veteran manager Rod Peterson.
#6 – Saskatoon Aspen Interiors – a rapidly improving scrappy squad that could move into the top five.
#7 – So Cal Bombers – if this west coast team plays to potential, it will be

among the top 3 in final ISC seedings.

#13 - Jarvis Merchants – local team that has added the pitching arm of Brian

Urquhart and could break the top 10.


